Lab is good for 30 days prior to surgery (please obtain >2 weeks before surgery if possible):

- CMP: Albumin <3.5 should be treated with protein supplementation and surgery may be delayed.
- CBC - if hemoglobin is less than 11.0, the patient should be worked up and treated and surgery will be canceled. If hemoglobin is <11.5 for females or <12 for males, the patient should be worked up and treated, but surgery will proceed.
- PT/INR, PTT - for patients on Coumadin/Lovenox or history of bleeding disorders or hepatic disease
- Hemoglobin A1C within the last 3 months - for patients who are diabetic
 - If results are higher than 7.5, surgery will be canceled
- Nicotine test (if nicotine user/recently quit) - if positive, surgery will be canceled

Other screening requirements:

- EKG done within 1 year if:
 - Age>60, HTN, CVD, morbid obesity (BMI>40), lung disease, or if indicated
 - EKG must be signed with interpretation
- Cardiac Stress Test passed within 6 months if 3 or more criteria met:
 - Ischemic heart disease, CVD, diabetes, renal insufficiency or heart failure
- Chest XRay within 4 weeks of bronchitis, pneumonia, productive cough, or as indicated
